



## Classic Antler Mounts LLC

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### Shipping Instructions \*Customers responsible for all shipping costs.

**SHIPPING:** Parcel rates are calculated by dimensional weight based on the size of the box/crate. Make sure your name, address, and telephone number are clearly written on all required forms.

**SKULLS:** Raw skulls/skins must be frozen solid, do not ship rancid or unfrozen skulls. Rubbermaid totes or Styrofoam insulated boxes work well. Wrap frozen skulls/skins in heavy duty black plastic bags to prevent blood transfer. If you have questions or concerns about skull preparation, please call us.

**ANTLERS:** We strongly recommend protecting antler tine tips, using plumbing pipe foam insulation (available at any hardware store) to prevent damage or possible box puncture while in transit.

**HIDES/FURS:** Be sure skins are thoroughly fleshed and salt dried before shipping. Do not forget to split and dry the tail. Skins must be completely dry upon receipt or you risk spoilage. Damp salted hides will spoil in storage or shipping. Freeze hides if you are unable to prepare or process in a timely manner.

**PACKING:** Use Styrofoam or newspaper to protect and insulate items inside the box/tote. Please DO NOT use the U.S. Postal Service when shipping frozen skulls, we recommend UPS or FedEx.

**DEPOSIT:** In order to insure your mount is completed in a timely manner, a (50%) deposit is required on all work orders. We accept Checks, Credit Cards by phone and Online Payments through Paypal®.

**INVOICE:** Upon completion of your work order, we will contact you and send the final invoice for any remaining balance including \*shipping costs. We securely package your project for return shipping and provide a tracking number.
